	Course Name	Intermediate Korean Language with K-Culture

	Course Description	<p>This four-week-course is specially designed for students who have basic knowledge of Korean to acquire the intermediate level of four skills (listening, speaking, reading and writing) through Korean Culture. Each day will consist of 3 hours of lecture and activity sessions. Students will learn one aspect of Korean culture (music, poem, art, history, custom, food, short story, etc.) each day and gain the related grammar, vocabulary, and expressions during the lecture. Then, they will practice the learned knowledge in pairs or in small groups during the activity sessions. Further practice opportunities are given during after class hours using online tools (Soundcloud) and projects (Virtual Story Book, Interview, and Welcome to Korea). Through these real-life-oriented practices and using authentic materials, students will be able to briefly describe and narrate about the topics that are familiar to them in the real world. Also, this Project-Based and Content-Based course will maximize students' Korean learning through frequent interactions with native speakers and using live resources while they stay in Korea.</p>				
	Course Objective	<p>The goal of this course is to be exposed to Korean culture, refine survival skills in Korean, and broaden the scope of everyday conversation to an intermediate level.
